# Opening Remarks and Welcome

Mr. Ismail Mbani Health and sanitation committee assistance chairperson made the opening remarks:

# Changes for 2015



### Reorganization

The Board of Directors approved the recommendation of LIFT's Management Team to reduce the number of program committees. The reorganization was requested to,

- 1. To better align the organization to LIFT's mission.
- 2. To direct LIFT's limited resources to those programs that align with its mission.
- 3. To have a bigger impact by focusing LIFT's resources on its core objectives.
- 4. To give other members an opportunity to serve on LIFT committees.
- 5. To give existing committee members, including chairpersons, an opportunity to reaffirm their availability to serve
- 6. To align together those programs that significantly serves the same purpose

# Agenda 06

Program Committee Updates

The LIFT two 2015 program committees presented their reports; Education and Health & sanitation.

Education-Presented by Mr. Ally Seif

Mr. Ally Seif had mainly two reports to report that was

- 1. Construction of an Early child development center at Mchinga 1 village,
- He explained about the main goals of the project. Including Construction and provision of quality ECD center infrastructure so as to bring about sustainable learning environment and provision for improved primary school readiness to Mchinga I village and nearby villages. Building strong foundation of Islamic knowledge to these children's as well as providing employment opportunities to the people of Mchinga villages
- The project involves the construction of buildings to house, equip and furnish an Early Child Development center at Mchinga I village in Lindi district of Tanzania. The Phase 1 construction entails the building of one block comprising one large classrooms to accommodate 50 boys and girls of pre-primary school age and attached office, one block for prayer hall, one block for kitchen and dining hall, one block for two teachers quarters one block to house administration offices and lecture hall, one block for staff toilets, one block for student toilets, a playing grounds, and a thatched roof open banda/hut for outside activities.

- He also explained about the status of the project and accomplished activities were well
  identified including. Ownership of land legally, clearance of the forest and finding
  community task force. And lastly finding a specialist who will be managing the project.
- In this report he lastly mentioned the main challenges that affects the project being resources (financial, human and time)

# 2. LIFT Second Annual Ramadan Quran Recitation Contest

The Second Annual Ramadan Quran Recitation Contest was held on July 11, 2015, Ilulu Stadium Lindi Tanzania. In this Quran Recitation Contest More than sixty students from 12 Islamic Schools (madrassas) competed in 4 categories (Juz), whereby we had 29 contestants for Juz 1, 21 for Juz 2, 8 for Juz 3 and 8 for Juz 4. This has become a good event to boost children's habit to read quran and increase their Iman.

Health-Presented by Dr. Zulfa Msami Dr Zulfa had two main projects as well

- 1. LIFT Cervical Cancer Screening Program January 2015 with partner Stepping Together Inc. (USA)
- 2. Cervical Cancer Screening Program August 1-9 2015 with partner Stepping Together Inc. (USA)
- During 2014/15 the health committee has paid much attention on ddoing cervical cancer screening for 300 cancer also doing follow ups on improving the health of those women who were screened and found with the problem. The committee was able to form and select areas where the program will be carried out for the period of October and December. 2014 Those areas selected were Kitomanga, Mchinga, Kilangala, Mvuleni, Mipingo, Namkongo, and Kingulungudwaand Kilolabwani. The Total number of women who were registered were 273.
- In January 2015 the health committee in cooperation with stepping together from America made another cervical cancer screening program for 220 women. Among 224 women who have been registered 2 women were found with symptoms of cervical cancer. And two (2) women were found with cancer the processes to treat those women started whereby they were sent to Dar es salaam for treatments but unfortunately one died but the other one is doing well enough
- August 2015 the health committee arranged follow up program for those who have been screened in January. Besides the follow up program the committee also participate in Nanenane grounds during agricultural ceremonies with the program of cervical cancer screening program where by 104 women were screened as well as 17 women among the 20 women who were screened during January were screened once again

- The health and sanitation committee also participated in the independency ceremonies event by providing sanitation equipment's including brooms, slashers, carriers at Mnonela village which were used for 09 Dec 2015 as the honorable fifth president of Tanzania Dr John Pombe Joseph Magufuli announced that day to be used for cleanness.
- The main challenge in this committee was once again resource including time to participate in this activities, constrained budget and human resources.
  - 3. Qurbani/ Udhiya Program Dhul Hijjah 1436 (2015)

Another project that was presented was the Qurbani programwhereby cows and goats/sheep were distributed in different areas in Lindi during Dhul Hijjah which could be used by the people during 'Eid el hajj ceremony. In this program 26 cows were distributed in 20 areas of Lindi and Kilwa also 77 goats/sheep's were distributed in 13 areas in Lindi and Kilwa as well.

  - 2) Iftar Ramadhan program
  - 3) Health screening program

- 4) Quran contest
- 5) Ramadhan Iftar program
- Lastly he talked about pledges including reminding members who promised to contribute money for LIFT and encourage others to provide financial and personnel assistance as well

# Agenda 08

Important announcement and Discussion Facilitated by Ismail Mbani

- Mr. Ismail Mbani introduced Nuru Ally as a new member and LIFT Project Coordinator
  who will be working in LIFT office and be responsible for management of all LIFT
  projects and Nuru was given a chance to introduce herself.
- One of the members suggested that not only Nuru should introduce herself but all members in the meeting should introduce one's self so that we can know each other well. Introduction process started and all members introduced themselves.
- One of the member asked "The Early Child Development center that is going to be constructed at Mchinga 1, in which environment will it be? And what about those people who are not staying at Mchinga 1 since the distance will be too far for the children to afford to go on their own?" Ally Seif who is the chairperson of education committee responded that the school is at Mchinga 1 in an area famously called Minara miwili on the top of a small mountain. This projects will benefit mostly the people living in Mchinga 1 as they will be close to the school but that does not mean that only children from Mchinga 1 should/would be enrolled in the school, instead every parent who can afford to take their children from the nearby villages to the school are warmly welcomed
- A member asked that LIFT is well understood now in Lindi and it is smoothly growing but why do we still have that small office? What about constructing another new office??...Dr. Nur responded to the question that "we cannot use the money dedicated for other programs to build an office, people provide their donations in specific areas for instance education then that money has to be allocated for education programs and not otherwise unless if there is money remaining, but also it the matter of priorities we can let people suffer with problems because we want to build an office we must help target population first" Mr. Ismail Mbani also added ideas on the same thing that LIFT is still a small organization for now we do not have enough money to build the office but we have little that can solve small problems that our Muslim brothers and sisters face, but when LIFT gets enough money and grows up even more a new and nice office will be built.
- A member who was her first time attending the meeting suggested that we should not
  mainly depend on external donors, instead we should find means which LIFT could have
  its own source of fund, and that suggestion was agreed by many members.
- Another question was asked about what does Islamic rules say for the cases where the money donated for Qurbani has remained... Mahmood, LIFT Board Chair, responded

that the sharia says, "the money is supposed to be given to those people who engaged themselves in Qurbani processes including transportation, delivery etc." but LIFT still has that remaining amount of money because those who were given that money provided that money back to LIFT so as it could be used for other programs.

Many people suggested that LIFT should find a way to remind those who have signed for pledges.
